





OUR VISITORS



The club was established in 1919 as Brotherhoods Engineering Works, and joined the Northants League (which later became the United Counties League) for the 1919–20 season. The club won the league in their first season, but left at the end of the 1922–23 season. They transferred to Division Three of the Peterborough & District League, which they won in 1925–26, earning promotion to Division Two.

The club was dormant in 1929–30 and 1932–33, after which it dropped into Division Three North. Despite only finishing eleventh in 1936–37, the club were elevated to Division Two for the 1937–38 season. After World War II the club were placed in Division One, where they remained until finishing bottom of the table in 1948–49, resulting in relegation to Division Two. In 1952 the division was renamed Division One as the division above became the Premier Division, but the club finished bottom in 1952–53 and were relegated to the new Division Two. In 1963–64 they were relegated again to Division Three South, but returned to Division Two after a single season.

In 1973–74 the club was relegated to Division Three South for a second time, but returned to Division Two after winning the division in 1975–76. Relegated again in 1979–80, the club returned to Division Two at the first attempt as Division Three South champions, and were promoted to Division One at the end of the 1982–83 season after finishing third.

The 1987–88 season saw the club finish as Division One runners-up and earn promotion to the Premier Division. In 1999 the club changed its name to Bearings Direct, and then again in 2001 to Peterborough Sports.

The club's most successful year came in the 2006/07 season when both the Peterborough Premier Division and Northants Junior Cup were secured for the only time in the club's history and in season 2010/11 the club secured its first ever PFA trophy when lifting the Challenge Cup as they were promoted back to the Peterborough League Premier Division. In 2012–13 Sports were promoted to Division One of the United Counties League after finishing third.

The club badge and turbines nickname pays homage to the club's roots with Brotherhoods Engineering Works, famous for designing and manufacturing the world's first steam turbine engine.



On target for the hosts with two goals each were Adam Spalding and Ben Diamond, while Ashley Ogden grabbed one.

Yaxley returned from Leicester Nirvana with a 2-0 victory thanks to goals from Stuart Wall and Dan Cotton. Boston Town's misery near the foot of the table was deepened by a 4-1 defeat at Cogenhoe United. Matt Long grabbed a first half hat-trick and Sean McBride grabbed the fourth. Oadby Town returned from Peterborough Northern Star with a 2-1 win, thanks to goals from Carlton Beardmore and Harry Alcock.

Jason Turner, Will Arnold and Alan Davies were on target for Desborough Town in their 3-2 win at Sleaford Town. Hosts Harborough Town beat Rothwell Corinthians 2-1, second-placed Eynesbury Rovers were held to a 4-4 draw at Northampton Sileby Rangers and, in the Capital knockout Cup, Holbeach United lost 4-2 at home to Olney Town from the lower division.
